

Mission House Church Voting Procedures

Central Church is considering changes to the current use of Central's Mission House. Members of Central will be taking a vote on the recommendations of the Elder Board and Property Board on the weekend of February 17-18. Below is more information on this suggested course of action.

Mission House Recommendation:

Upon the recommendation of the Property Board, the Elder Board unanimously recommends the following:

Central Church shall lease the Mission House to Heartland Converge for a period of five years. At the end of the five-year leasing agreement, ownership of the Mission House shall be deeded to Heartland Converge.

Explanation:

Over the past four years the Mission House has been used one week for a missionary family, a Central staff member lived there for one and one-half years, it was empty for a year, and currently a family in need (not a missionary family) is staying there.

The five-year transition period, before deeding the house to Heartland, will ensure that the conference's plans for use of the house will fulfill the intended purpose of the property. Heartland Converge will utilize the house to provide temporary housing for pastoral staff from 61 Heartland churches, for pastoral care/counseling, respite and renewal time, visiting missionaries, ministry staff in transition, and Heartland Converge church members in need of temporary housing. The house will still be available to Central missionaries as well.
