CONVERSATION WITH GOD

As Pastor Jeff has been sharing with us the past couple of weeks, prayer is simply having a conversation with God, and being willing to respond to the urgent needs of heaven. Perhaps one way to remain in the right frame of mind throughout the day is to listen to Christian worship music. You may find that choosing music that is uplifting and brings life creates a more natural flow of communication with God.

Many families have found that listening to Christian radio stations or worship music in the car allows for opportunities to talk about God in instances that may be unplanned, but scripted by the Holy Spirit.

In the Sioux Falls region, there are several great options for Christian music on the radio. FM stations Life 96.5, 90.1 (KLOVE), and 105.5 (Refuge Radio) are sources for contemporary Christian music, and 1270 AM (Faith Radio) has Christian teaching content (Focus on the Family, Chuck Swindoll, David Jeremiah, among others) that airs throughout the day.

Consider creating a more worshipful atmosphere in your car, your home, your office, or in your earphones at the gym by choosing wholesome, uplifting music.

Perhaps more meaningful and intentional conversations with God – and with others – will occur!

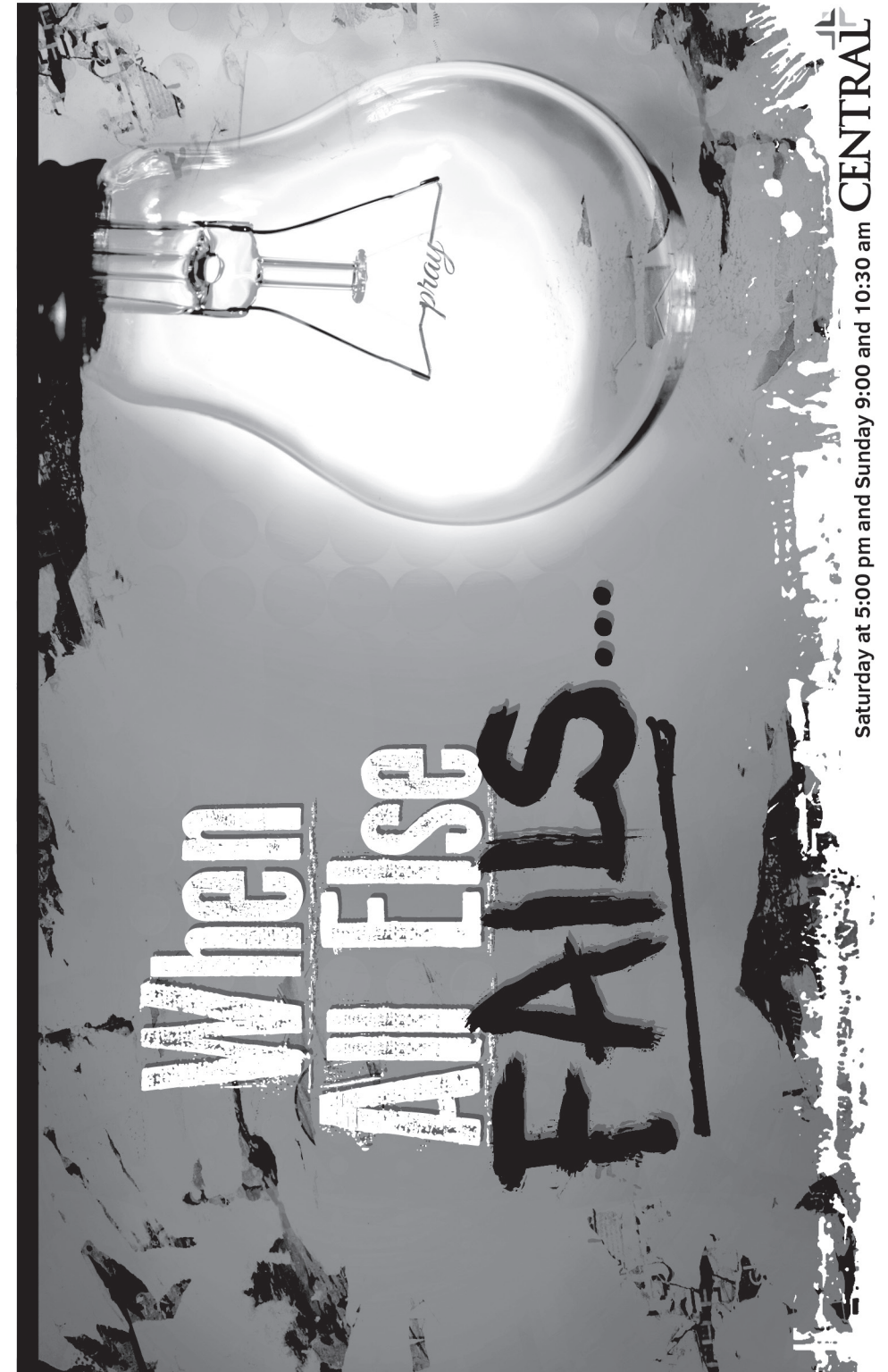
