

# The Jesus Way to Pray

Part 6: Revealing God's Glory

Acts 4:23-31

## Launch

*What three adjectives come to mind when you hear "Prayer Meeting?" Why?*

## Explore

### Read the passage

When Peter and John were released from jail, they went back and reported all that had happened. Luke says that in response, they raised their voices in prayer. This doesn't sound like a boring prayer meeting attended out of obligation or guilt, but rather it seems that they couldn't help but pray. *What is different here from our common experience?*

The prayer contains a quote from a Psalm. **Read Psalm 2.**

*How does this Psalm relate to their current situation? What are some of the thoughts it expresses concerning Jesus? What assurances and hope would this Psalm provide the believers? Why was that appropriate to pray back to God?*

*What three things did the disciples pray for? How did God answer them?*

## Apply

*When has prayer been easiest and most natural for you? Why do you think we find prayer so difficult?*

Supernatural signs and wonders reveal God's power, compassion, glory, and goodness. *How have you seen this in your life?*

*During our A429 Prayer Focus, which of these three things do you most want experience the most: boldness to speak, God's hand to heal, or unexplainable answers to prayer?*

## Pray

Pray that we would experience passionate, powerful times of prayer, seeing God reveal his glory and people placing their faith in Him.
