Foundations #4 - Prayer Opens the Door For God's Power

### **Launch**

Reflecting on the sermon, how does the idea that prayer opens the door for God's power resonate with you personally? Do you find it challenging or encouraging? Why?

### **Explore**

Read Luke 5:15-17; Mark 6:53-56

Considering the results of prayer in Jesus' life mentioned in these passages, which aspect stands out to you the most? Why do you think that is?

Read Mark 9:25-29 - The sermon mentions Satan's influence and how prayer can break those chains. What areas in your life or the lives of those around you do you think could benefit from the power of prayer in overcoming Satan's influence?

Read Mark 11:20-24 - In this passage, Jesus mentioned moving mountains through faith in prayer. How does this challenge or expand your view of the possibilities of prayer in your own life and the lives of others?

### **Apply**

Considering the overall theme of the sermon, if you were to apply one lesson about prayer opening the door for God's power in your life, what specific step or action would you take? How can you make prayer a more intentional and transformative part of your daily routine?

### **Pray**

Take time this week to pause before you walk through a door to remember how prayer opens a door to God's power. If you have kids, as you open their bedroom doors in the morning - pause and pray for God's power to be released in them.
