Launch

What is your current perception of your role within the church? Do you see yourself as a participant, a spectator, or somewhere in between?

Explore

What foundations did Jesus provide for building the church, according to the sermon? Consider aspects like the importance of lost people, personal responsibility, and the concept of oikos.

According to Ephesians 4, how does Jesus equip and empower believers to be active participants in His work? Discuss the concept of grace and the gifts given to each believer.

Read I Peter 2:4-5, 9. Explore the role of priests in the Old Testament and how believers are referred to as priests in the New Testament. How does being a priest relate to the idea of every Christian being in the game?

Jesus sends believers out to do the works He did. What are some of the works mentioned in the sermon that Christians are called to do? How does this challenge our understanding of the extent of our impact on the world?

Apply

Reflect on the places where the "game" is played, as mentioned in the sermon (in the church, in our oikos). How can you practically apply one lesson from the sermon to step into the game this week? Share a specific action you plan to take.
