The fruits of being offended:

1. _____: This is the emotion attached to injustice. I've been wronged; that was unfair; there needs to be repayment.
2. _____: This is escalating anger; being filled with anger. We no longer think rationally; this is where we begin to blame others.
3. _____: This is the desire to harm the person. It is developing evil intentions for them.
4. _____: This means lying about the person to others.
5. _____: These are words spoken about the person that are disparaging and harmful.
6. _____: This is refusing to be around them.
7. _____: This is seeking our own revenge and forcing them to pay us back for what they did to us.
